In an effort to support students' consumer choice, limit extra costs, and take advantage of new programs in place through the Affordable Care Act, Adler University will stop automatic enrollment in a school-offered plan effective Fall 2014. Instead, students are encouraged to enroll in a private health insurance plan that best meets individual needs.

- Coverage as a Dependent
- Coverage through Medicaid
- Coverage and Tax Credits through the Marketplace
- Coverage under a Catastrophic Plan
